**DOMESTIC VIOLENCE  
NOTICE**

If you are the victim of a domestic violence, you can ask the City prosecuting Attorney to file a criminal complaint. You also have the right to file a petition in Superior Court requesting an Order for Protection from domestic abuse which could include any of the following;

1. An order restraining your abuser from further acts of abuse;
2. An order directing your abuser to leave your household;
3. An order preventing your abuser from entering your residence, school, business or place of employment;
4. An order restraining your abuser from molesting or interfering with minor children in your custody.

The forms you need to obtain a Protection Order are available in Superior Court: Pierce County Superior Court, Room 108, County-City Building 930 Tacoma Avenue South, Tacoma, Wa., 98402.
