### STOLEN VEHICLE WARNING NOTICE

The Monroe Police Department receives many complaints of stolen vehicles where the suspect is the victim's child, relative, or close friend. Because of the problems this sometimes causes, the following warnings are given to the victim prior to them signing a stolen vehicle report.

1. There is a risk that the suspect may be involved in an accident or shot at during an apprehension attempt.
2. The suspect may be arrested and incarcerated upon apprehension.
3. The suspect may be prosecuted regardless of the victim's desires. This should be of particular interest to those parents reporting only because their runaway child has the vehicle and when the child and vehicle have been returned, they request no formal charges.
4. The suspect, if convicted, may be sentenced to jail or prison.
5. Upon conviction, the suspect will have a criminal record showing a felony conviction.

This is not meant to indicate that any of the above will definitely occur, however, the possibilities should be considered prior to signing the stolen vehicle report.
