- Open criminal charges/pending criminal proceedings.
- Other U.S. Code violations.
- Outstanding warrant for arrest.
- Prohibited convictions.
- Subject to a court order or injunction regarding firearms.
- Under current supervision of the Department of Corrections
- If your pistol License is being revoked:** All pistols purchased during the period that you possessed the license must be transferred from your possession within 14 days of the date listed above. By the end of the 15th day you must produce, to this department, satisfactory evidence of having lawfully transferred ownership of the pistol(s). Failure to comply with this requirement will result in criminal charges.
