WHAT IS A SIG?

A Special Interest Group is a controlled/structured-access area for specialized organizations or disciplines to share and store information as a means to enhance collaboration with law enforcement, intelligence and emergency management communities.



SIG RESOURCES

Each SIG comes with a listserv, calendar, and address book. The listserv allows SIG moderators to easily reach every member of the SIG. The calendar is a great place to keep track of special events. The address book lists all public members of the SIG.

OTHER CAPABILITIES

EMAIL

With access to the SIGs and VCCs, members can receive a LEO.gov email address with their account. This capability allows users to send and receive secure email between SIG and VCC users and other partnering government and law enforcement email domains.

VCC TRAX

An operational tool that can be used to track persons of interest within the Virtual Command Center. Create and update suspect profiles to better track persons of interest with this easy-to-manage resource.

VIRTUAL OFFICE

Agencies can store and retrieve information from any Internet connection. An officer no longer has to travel to the office to get documents!

LISTSERVS

A listserv is a mailing list that allows members to easily reach everyone subscribed to the listserv. Listservs are automatically created with each SIG but can be requested outside of a SIG through the Help Desk. Listserv messages are delivered by moderators or with a moderator's approval.

WHAT IS A VCC?

A Virtual Command Center is a real-time, collaborative tool that facilitates shared situational awareness and event management.

VCC USAGE

The VCC can be used for operations/events such as:

Active Shooter
Warrant Operations
Special Events
Natural Disasters
Child Abductions
Terrorist Attacks and Threats
